

RECOMMENDED GOLF COURSES AROUND THE RED ROCK RESORT

Summerlin is home to Southern Nevada's most prestigious golf neighborhoods, allowing our guests access to a variety of Las Vegas golf facilities.

BEAR'S BEST

Bear's Best Las Vegas offers a remarkably distinctive golf experience. Jack Nicklaus selected 18 holes from his more than 200 course designs worldwide allowing golfers to play holes from courses such as Castle Pines, Muirfield, and PGA West. This course gives golfers the opportunity to play 18 of Jack Nicklaus' favorite golf holes in one majestic round of golf. Each hole was selected by the Golden Bear to flow perfectly in creating this one-of-a-kind golf experience. Par 72 and 6,628 yards from the middle tees.

ARROYO

This course is an Arnold Palmer Signature course and is the only course at Red Rock Country Club open to the public. Stretching 6,857 yards and playing the Arroyo is a rare mix of compelling design and exceptional beauty. Bold bunkering, dramatic water hazards and the stark contrast of emerald greens against the tanned desert mountain, make the Arroyo as visually striking as it is challenging. This links style layout with Bermuda grass fairways and Bentgrass greens will challenge every level of player. It has five sets of tee boxes to suit all golfers' abilities. The Arroyo Course plays 6,433 yards from the middle tees and is a par 72.

SIENA

This course combines striking bunkers, a long front nine, and tough pin placement possibilities to make Siena a challenge. Surviving Siena's first five holes is a big key to a successful round. The variances of length, direction, strategy and uphill-downhill holes make the course both challenging and enjoyable for all golfers. Par 72 and plays 6,538 yards from the middle tees.

TPC LAS VEGAS

This Bobby Weed and Raymond Floyd course is designed for the PGA Tour. It features a variety of trees, elevation changes, steep ravines, and a large canyon lake. With Bermuda grass tees, and fairways that fade into rough of bent grass greens, this is desert golfing at its finest. Truly one of the best course in Nevada. Par 71 and playing 6,772 yards from the middle tees.

BADLANDS


Designed by Johnny Miller and Chi Chi Rodriguez, this course features the best in desert landscaping, highlighting arroyos, gorges, and canyons, along with incredible views of the Vegas skyline. With 27 holes (three sets of 9): Desperado-Diablo 6,926 yards, Diablo Outlaw 6,802 yards, and Outlaw-Desperado 6,602 yards, you can choose any combination of nines and still shoot for a par of 72.

ANGEL PARK

Two plush Arnold Palmer-designed courses and a lighted 12-hole (par-3) Cloud Nine Short Course make Angel Park the most diversified golf facility in the city.

The Mountain Course: This course winds through rolling desert terrain and dense stands of native desert vegetation to cover 6,722 yards. This par 71 course is challenging enough for the most seasoned golfer, yet forgiving enough for those of us who aren't PGA professionals. At an elevation of nearly 3,000 feet, the Mountain Course boasts spectacular views of Spring Mountain, Red Rock Mountain and the Las Vegas skyline. The course plays 6,722 yards and is a par 71.





The Palm Course: Ideal for all levels of golfers, especially beginning and intermediate, but with enough challenge for even the best golfers in your group. This beautiful course is a reminder of Las Vegas courses of old. The wide fairways and multiple tee placements are ideal for beginning and intermediate golfers, but you'll need plenty of distance off the tees and lots of finesse to tackle the rolling greens. The course plays 6,530 yards and is a par 70.

RHODES RANCH

Designed by renowned architect Ted Robinson, the layout provides a unique blend of challenge and playability to golfers of all skill levels. Highlighted by a group of par threes which Robinson calls the very best that he has ever designed, this 6,909 yard course will envelop you in its lush tropical surroundings while providing you with a world class golf experience.

PAIUTE

Three magnificent championship golf courses conceived and designed by world-renowned architect Pete Dye. Enjoy the natural serenity and tranquility that only the Las Vegas Paiute Golf Resort can offer.

Snow Mountain: The inaugural course for the master planned Pete Dye-designed Las Vegas Paiute Resort, offers a total of 7,146 yards with a par 72 layout. You will find no parallel fairways with wide rye grass fairways, and a variety of tee lengths and angles. Natural areas separate each hole with the help of 7 water hazard holes. Play is 6,645 yards from the middle tees.

Sun Mountain: Shining at 7,112 total yards, is the tamest of the courses but the holes are every bit as good. A kinder, gentler Dye design, it's depicted by natural rolling terrain and enchanting scenery. Many golfers hail the Sun as their favorite because they feel like they are on the edge of nature due to the location of the course being completely away from the resort's interior. Play is 6,631 yards from the middle tees.

Wolf: The most-difficult layout, howls at 7,604 total yards and is the longest course in Nevada. It promises an amazing golf experience, thanks to its length, the beauty of its natural desert surroundings, and its stunning island green on the fifteenth hole. Golfers of all skill levels can come take a bite out of the infamous WOLF by tempering the challenge with five tee options at various yardages. Play is 6,483 yards from the middle tees.
