

GOLF IN AND AROUND THE RED ROCK HOTEL

RED ROCK ARROYO

This brand-new course is an Arnold Palmer Signature Course. The Arroyo Course plays 6,433 yards from the middle tees and is a par 72. This links style layout with Bermuda grass fairways and Bentgrass greens will challenge every level of player. It has five sets of tee boxes to suit all golfers' abilities.

RED ROCK SIENA

This brand-new course combines striking bunkers, a long front nine, and tough pin placement possibilities to make Siena a challenge. Surviving Siena's first five holes is a big key to a successful round. The variances of length, direction, strategy and uphill-downhill holes make the course both challenging and enjoyable for all golfers. Par 72 and plays 6,538 yards from the middle tees.

TPC CANYONS

This Bobby Weed and Raymond Floyd course is designed for the PGA Tour. It features a variety of trees, elevation changes, steep ravines, and a large canyon lake. With Bermuda grass tees, and fairways that fade into rough of bent grass greens, this is desert golfing at its finest. Truly one of the best course in Nevada. Par 71 and playing 6,772 yards from the middle tees. Mandatory Caddies.

ANGEL PARK

The Mountain Course is desert golf at its finest. This course winds through rolling desert terrain and dense stands of native desert vegetation to cover 6,722 yards. This par 71 course is challenging enough for the most seasoned golfer, yet forgiving enough for those of us who aren't PGA professionals. At an elevation of nearly 3,000 feet, the Mountain Course boasts spectacular views of Spring Mountain, Red Rock Mountain and the Las Vegas skyline. The course plays 6,722 yards and is a par 71.

The Palm Course is ideal for all levels of golfers, especially beginning and intermediate, but with enough challenge for even the best golfers in your group. This beautiful course is a reminder of Las Vegas courses of old. The wide fairways and multiple tee placements are idea for beginning and intermediate golfers, but you'll need plenty of distance off the tees and lots of finesse to tackle the rolling greens. The course plays 6,530 yards and is a par 70.

PAIUTE GOLF RESORT

Resting in the undisturbed beauty of the Southern Nevada desert at the base of the picturesque Spring Mountains lies a golfing experience like no other...The Las Vegas Paiute Golf Resort. Three magnificent championship golf courses conceived and designed by world-renowned architect Pete Dye. Enjoy the natural serenity and tranquility that only the Las Vegas Paiute Golf Resort can offer. Snow Mountain which opened in March of 1995, has been rated the best public course in Las Vegas by Golf Digest and Las Vegas' Where magazine. Play is 6,645 yards from the middle tees. Sun Mountain was opened in August of 1996 and is rated as among the top 200 golf courses you can play in all of North America BY Golf Digest. Play is 6,631 yards from the middle tees.

Wolf Opened in November of 2001, this course was rated the best golf course you can play for under \$200 by Vegas Golfer. Play is 6,483 yards from the middle tees.

BADLANDS

Badlands Golf Club is located just 25 minutes north of the Strip. Designed by Johnny Miller and Chi Chi Rodriguez, this course features the best in desert landscaping, highlighting arroyos, gorges, and canyons, along with incredible views of the Vegas skyline. With 27 holes (three sets of 9): Desperado-Diablo, Diablo Outlaw, and Outlaw-Desperado, you can choose any combination of nines and still shoot for a par of 72.

BEAR'S BEST

Mr. Nicklaus had one thing in mind with the concept for Bear's Best – Las Vegas. Take 18 signature holes that he's designed from throughout the region and put them together to create a golfing experience like none-other. The 7,194 yard layout features four sets of tees, allowing all levels of players an enjoyable and memorable golf experience. Another unique feature is the Forecaddie Program. Top shelf forecaddies give yardages, rake bunkers, tend flags, fix ball marks, keep play moving at a pleasant pace and best of all, read putts! These caddies know the course so well, you'll save several stroke per round on the greens alone. Located on the West end of Flamingo Road, Bear's Best – Las Vegas has also played host to the PGA Tour's Michelin Championships. Par 72.
